The Appellant Medical College has filed the First Appeals dated 22.12.2025 under Section 28(5) of the National Medical Commission Act, 2019, challenging the LoD dated 15.12.2025 issued by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board (MARB). The College had applied for starting/increasing seats in postgraduate courses for the academic year (AY) 2025-26. Upon examination, the MARB issued the impugned LoP/LoD for the following relevant postgraduate courses for AY 2025-26.

2. The aforesaid First Appeal has been admitted, and the Appeal Committee, constituted under the Chairmanship of Dr. Abhijat Chandrakant Sheth, Chairman, NMC and two Members, met on 30.12.2025 to consider the said Appeals filed by the Medical College. The following Appeal Committee members were present during the meeting:

- b. Dr. D. K. Sharma, Medical Superintendent, Dr. Rajender Prasad Centre for Ophthalmic Sciences, All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Delhi - **Member**
- c. Prof. (Dr.) Gangadhar Taduri, Department of Nephrology, Nizam Institute of Medical Sciences (NIMS), Hyderabad, Telangana- **Member**

3. The Appeal Committee has given a virtual hearing to the Medical College on 30.12.2025, represented by the Dean/Principal/Vice-Principal/HoD. The Medical College duly presented its submissions during the hearing.

4. The Committee duly reviewed the records available and the submissions of the Medical College. The Committee has also examined the Standard Assessment Form (SAF)/Physical Assessment Report, AEBAS attendance Report, Infrastructure, Clinical workload and availability of faculty in the applied departments. The Committee also reviewed the HIMS data and undertaking submitted by the medical college regarding the availability of faculty as per applicable norms. 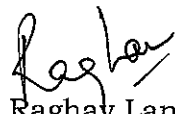
